

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT
APPROVED BY THE BARRE TOWN VOTERS ON May 11, 2010

Article 22. Shall the town of Barre amend Section 12 of the Barre Town Charter as follows (underlined language would be added and [~~bracketed~~] language would be deleted):

Section 12 Auditors

Auditors shall be elected for terms of three (3) years, with one (1) elected each year. They shall be responsible for the proper financial accountability of the town, and for this purpose all town officers shall, within thirty (30) days after the close of the fiscal year, submit to the auditors such reports, records and materials as the auditors may require for the discharge of their duties. The auditors shall thereupon proceed to examine and adjust the accounts of all town officers and report their findings in writing, not later than [~~one hundred (100)~~] one hundred eighty-five (185) days after the close of the fiscal year. They shall cause their findings to be printed and made available to the voters. The auditors may employ the services of a certified public accountant at town expense, for such purposes as they shall deem proper. They shall also supervise the preparation, publication, and, within budgetary limitations, the distribution of the annual town report.
