Approved for the following highways in the TOWN OF BARRE:

Farwell Street, Pine Hill Road, Plainfield Brook Road (aka Gunner Brook Road), Windywood Road, Cummings Road, Hill Street (city line to West Cobble Hill Road), East and West Cobble Hill Road, Airport Road, Upper Prospect Street (from Airport Rd. to Morrison Road), Morrison Road (from Allen Street to Airport Road), Bridge Street (from #47 Reynolds & Son to Allen Street), Church Hill Road, Graniteville Road (from #773 former Tourist Center to Cogswell St.), Cogswell Street, Allen Street (from Morrison to #219 Booth Bros./Hood Dairy), Snowbridge Road (from Rt. 14 to #39 Carroll Concrete building). *If it becomes necessary to travel other than the above-mentioned roads in the Town of Barre, you are required to have this permit amended (in writing) to include those roads.*

Permits are *not* required to travel Quarry Hill Road, Graniteville Road (to #773 former Tourist Center), Websterville Road, Pitman Road, Parker Road and Sterling Hill (from Quarry Hill to #169 MacAuley Meats building).

Trucks are not allowed on the Bridge Street bridge or on Holden Road.

List primary destination points within Town of Barre: _____
Truckers must use the shortest route off of permitted roads to reach destination points on unpermitted streets.

This approval shall be effective for no more than a one-year period ending March 31, 2011. This approval shall cover all vehicles bearing the company name. If permit is to cover *unmarked* company trucks, please attach a list to this form giving year and make of truck, VIN #, maximum weight and registration #.

The holder of a permit shall be liable for any damage to highways or bridges and is **required to furnish the Town of Barre a valid Certificate of Insurance** in the following amounts: a minimum of \$100/\$300,000 Personal Injury Liability Coverage and \$100,000 Property Damage Coverage.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANT

1. Permit is valid for up to one year expiring on March 31.
2. You must include a valid certificate of insurance in the amount of a minimum of \$100,000/\$300,000 Personal Injury Liability Coverage and \$100,000 Property Damage Coverage.
3. Please include \$5.00 for each single vehicle application, or \$10.00 for a fleet permit.
4. Permits must be carried in the permitted truck.

3. Special weight limits which are higher or lower than legal limits for highways or bridges within your jurisdiction must be on file with the Vermont Department of Motor Vehicles.
