## 6. Old Business.

***a) Barre Heritage Festival:*** Have you had any success recruiting members? Determine if there is interest and choose to either form or not form a committee. In order for the committee to be successful there needs to be enough time to plan fundraising events. A committee needs to be named in the very near future.

**Recommendation/ Action:** Determine if you would like to continue recruiting and then consider reporting your results to the Selectboard.

***b) East Barre playground brick reimbursement:*** Kathy Pelletier has submitted an invoice denoting the cost she incurred for the playground bricks. The total of the invoice is \$1016.01. In your December meeting you approved a motion reimbursing Kathy \$500.00 from “other supplies” account # 011.462.326. Please review the enclosed invoice and confirm your intentions.

**Recommendation/ Action:** Adopt a motion authorizing the use of recreation funds, account # 011.462.326 to reimburse Kathy Pelletier \$500.00 of the \$1016.01 she outlaid in the East Barre brick project.

***c) Playground Initiative:*** I spoke with Ron Lyon from Dubois & King and we can apply the Richardson Road grant money to Wilson Street. Melissa has been in touch with a contractor from Burlington who has helped build Town playgrounds in the past. He is open to attending a meeting if you would like to get some ideas from him. He could help with conceptual planning. However, you might want to wait to invite him until you have specific questions to ask. Let me know if you would like me to find out more (such as a name and an address). As I have mentioned in the past both Hannaford’s and MacDonald’s have charitable giving branches. We could apply for one or both of the grants once you put together a solid conceptual plan. First consider how you would like to see this playground developed (i.e. age groups, equipment, and space). In the past you mentioned that you would like to survey the area asking more specific questions. Think of some questions you would like to have on the survey. I will prepare a draft survey (to be distributed at the meeting) for you to look at. Come ready for a discussion.

**Recommendation/ Action:** Discuss, consider, and evaluate your options.

## 7. New Business:

***a) Edo Perantoni Bequest:*** Last week Edo Perantoni passed away. He was the Recreation Supervisor before Don Gainey. His family has requested, in lieu of flowers, that donations in remembrance of Edo be made to the Barre Town Recreation Department. Depending on the amount, you might consider using the money to fund one of your budget priorities (i.e. baseball scoreboard).

**Recommendation/ Action:** Consider how you might use this money to both honor and accomplish recreation goals on behalf of Edo Perantoni.
