

Construction Update
Barre City Paving (US 302 & VT 14)
NH 2961 (2) & STP 2961 (1)

Project Location: The project extends along US 302 from the Berlin/Barre City line through downtown Barre and continues on US 302/Washington Street to just before Poulin Auto. The project also includes VT 14/ Maple Ave to Hope Cemetery and South Main Street to Jockey Hollow.

Week of June 5, 2017

Night Work: Monday-Friday - 7:00 pm to 6:30 am

Crews are planning to start Milling, Monday night, June 5th, 2017 on US 302 at the Berlin/Barre City Line and work their way to the VT 14/VT 62 intersection on North Main Street by mid-week. Work will then continue on VT 14/Maple Ave to Hope Cemetery to finish out the week.

Milling operations will remove the top 2" of pavement leaving a grooved road surface.

Alternating one-way traffic will be maintained around the milling operations with traffic control personnel assisting in maintaining traffic flow.

Traffic – Traffic delays at night are expected throughout the week.

It is illegal in VT to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.
